## Directional Coaching Training

February 11-12, 2010 – Omaha, NE

### *Featuring:*

**Presentation of the TCN Directional Coaching Process.** Recently developed materials and resources will assist coaches of pastors and church leaders in the congregational transformation process to be laser focused on the critical issues which will turn churches around and refocus them on outreach. This is not general or “life” coaching, although a background in coaching general practice, such as is offered by the Center for US Missions, would be valuable. Directional coaching is specific to the transformational process and will provide the incentive and accountability necessary for church leaders to follow through with the prescriptions of the congregational consultation and put the concepts developed in the Learning Communities into practice. Materials will assist districts and congregations in the consultation, learning community and coaching phases of the process.

**Resource for Leading Change.** Seminal to the TCN process is the recognition by all participants that producing change in congregational and leadership behaviors will begin with confronting the need for change in oneself. One of three books TCN is highlighting in this respect will be discussed at this conference. ## *Who should attend this Training?*

- Consultants: Certified Consultants and Consultants in Training are responsible for coaching to follow up on the consultations, whether they do the coaching themselves or provide for others who will accomplish this important aspect of the transformational process.
- Coaches: Many districts have identified individuals who will be coaching pastors and church leaders in congregations that have undergone consultations.
- Pastors of churches that have undergone consultations. The ultimate success of the TCN process will rise and fall on the effectiveness of Coaching. The need to multiply effective coaches is, then paramount, and no one will know the value of coaching better than pastors who have seen the coaching process from the inside. Pastors who attend this training will be the best prospects for a future pool of excellent directional coaches.
- District Executives and others interested in the process. Those who are involved in the transformational process at any level will better understand the process they are supporting if they have had exposure to training in this basic component. This conference follows the NAME conference at the same facility, which will make this a great opportunity for Mission Executives to attend this training.
